TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

ON MARCH 27 12

The regular scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Turtlecreek Township was held on March 27, 2012 at 8:00 a.m. with the following person present:

TRUSTEES: Jonathan D. Sams, Jim VanDeGrift, and Dan Jones.

CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER: Tammy Boggs

GUEST: Steve Flint, Mike Jameson, Erin Monroe, Larry Wilson, Bradley A. Rawn, Michael King, John Radtke, and Michael Shaffer.

The meeting opened with Mr. Sams leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meeting were received by the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Since there were no additions or corrections, Mr. Jones moved for acceptance, seconded by Mr. VanDeGrift. All were in favor and the minutes were approved as written.

The Trustees had a discussion regarding the donation for Mr. George Terwilleger. A motion was made to donate \$300.00 to the Hamilton Township Park System in memory of Mr. George Terwilleger by Mr. Jones. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-03-10**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

The Fiscal Officer notified the Trustees that she was able to renew the Public Entity Insurance at a savings of \$478.00 from the original quoted price.

The Fiscal Officer reported that she and Mr. Sams met with LCNB and were able to reduce the Trustee fees for the investment account from .50% to .20% effective January 1, 2012.

The Fiscal Officer reminded the Trustees that the Public Hearing for Turtlecreek Zoning Commission will be held on April, 2012 at 7 p.m. and 8 p.m.

The Warren County Commissioners sent a letter requesting the Trustees issue a Resolution to rename US 42 throughout Warren County as "Warren County Veterans Highway. Mr. Jones made a motion to issue the resolution. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-03-06**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

The Fiscal Officer reported that Duke Energy has issued a revised street lighting for Shaker Run, Pod 5, Pt 2. The light locations are the same as before, but it appears that the cost has increased

Mr. Jones requested an executive session at the end of the meeting to discuss personnel issues.

Mr. Michael King addressed the Trustees regarding the request for an additional street light to be added to the Twin Oaks Lighting District. Mr. King requested that a letter be sent to all the property owners again clarifying the cost of the light. Mr. Sams requested that Mr. King obtain the reports from the Sheriff's office of all calls made to Twin Oaks. This matter will be continued for now.

The township received notification from Duke that they have requested a communication tower to be built on Turtlecreek Union Road. The Fiscal Officer reported to the Trustees that she has received objections to this tower from the residents in the area of Turtlecreek Union Road. Mr. John Radtke from Natalie Lane addressed the Trustees regarding his concerns with the tower. The Trustees informed Mr. Radtke that it is very important for the residents to voice their concerns with the Warren County Regional Planning and Warren County Commissioners. The Trustees will send a letter the Warren County Zoning Board and Duke.

Mr. Michael Shaffer informed the Trustees that the private roads at Shaker Run were discussed at the Warren County Regional Planning meeting.

Department Reports:

Fire/EMS: Steve Flint, Fire Chief, Mike Jameson, Assistant Fire Chief, and Erin Monroe, EMS Chief reported fire and EMS incident information. Effective February 8, 2012, Mr. Dan Hill will also be running on the Fire Department. His rate of pay will be the same as his EMS rate of pay which will be \$9.50 per hour. The Warren County Career Center has requested that the Trustees issue a resolution in support of the training tower. Mr. Jones made a motion for a resolution to support the training tower. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-03-05**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes). Assistant Chief Monroe requested the purchase of heat packs, manual updates and training equipment at the approximate cost of \$6,000.00. The EMS department received a grant

in the amount of \$6,000.00 that will reimburse the purchased items. Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to purchase the EMS items. Mr. Jones seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12.03.07**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes). Assistant Chief Jameson requested that five (5) personnel attend the swift water rescue training classes that will be sponsored by the township at a cost of \$270.00 per person.

Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to send five (5) township employees to the training. Mr. Jones seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-03-08**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

Road and Bridge: Larry Wilson, Road Supervisor, presented his weekly department activity reports completed since the previous meeting. Mr. Wilson requested the purchase of two (2) skids of crack sealer. The approximate cost of the sealer will be \$2,400.00. from DJL. Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to purchase the crack sealer. Mr. Jones seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 12-03-09**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes). Mr. Wilson discussed with the Trustees the Timbercreek II culvert issue. Mr. Wilson had two estimates of the cost to repair the culvert. This matter will be continued until the next meeting. Mr. Wilson discussed Mr. Armold's culvert on Wood Road. The Trustees requested that Mr. Wilson issue a letter to Mr. Armold's that the replacement of the culvert is his responsibility. Mr. Wilson reported that the township has approximately 36 miles of roadway that is not in subdivisions. The township has already chip sealed 13 miles of this 36 roadway miles.
