The regular scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Turtlecreek Township was held on May 27, 2014 at 8:00 a.m. with the following person present:

TRUSTEES: Dan Jones, Jonathan D. Sams (arrived 8:02), and Jim VanDeGriftCHIEF FISCAL OFFICER:Tammy BoggsGUEST:Steve Flint, Michael Jameson, Ron Chasteen, Chuck Petty, Gene Bustle, JonPaulCampbell, Beth Gully, Jennifer Niehaus, Greg Orosz, and Stan Williams.

The meeting opened with Mr. Jones leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meetings were received by the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Since there were no additions or corrections, Mr. VanDeGrift moved for acceptance, seconded by Mr. Sams. All were in favor and the minutes were approved as written.

Ms. Beth Gully, BT Graphics, Inc., made a presentation regarding branding and logo concepts. Ms. Gully discussed how branding and logo design helps to define an area and provide an identity. The Trustees will discuss this issue in the coming weeks and decide if they wish to proceed with this option.

Mr. Stan Williams, Warren County Regional Planning and Mr. Greg Orosz presented to the Trustees information regarding an Economic Development position for the township. This position would be created at the county level and Mr. Orosz would spend a portion of his time on township issues. The position would not be in place until 2015. The Trustees inquired as to how the position would work. Mr. Orosz and Mr. Williams stated that the county would pay the larger portion of Mr. Orosz salary and the township would pay a portion relative to the time Mr. Orosz worked on township issues. The Trustees will continue to discuss this matter in the future and decide if this is a position that the township would utilize.

Mr. Chuck Petty, Warren County Engineer's Office, discussed drainage issues in Buckeye Fields. This has been an issue for several years and recently the township has received complaints from the residents in this development. Mr. Petty informed the Trustees that the Engineer's Office will survey the subdivision to see if it conforms to the original plan. Mr. Petty will report back to the Trustees with the results and recommend steps to correct the water issue at a later date.

Ms. Boggs informed the Trustees that a public hearing for the vacation of Mulford Road will be held on June 10, 2014 at 9:30. Mr. Sams will attend the hearing.

Ms. Boggs informed the Trustees that she received a call requesting two cremation remains be placed in one cemetery lot. The township's cemetery rule's does not address this issue. The Trustees discussed this and have no objections to this as long as it is allowed per law. Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to allow this request pending the outcome from the prosecutor's office. Mr. Sams seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed.

The Warren County Regional Planning sent a record plat for the Estates of Keever Creek, Section 1, Phase 2D. The Trustees reviewed this plat and have no objections of concerns regarding this issue. A letter will be sent to the Warren County Regional Planning stating these facts.

Ms. Boggs notified the Trustees that they can place an assessment on the Freiberg property in the amount of the demolition cost. The Trustees discussed this issue and decided to place the assessment in the amount of the demolition cost of \$13,860.00. Mr. Sams made a motion to place an assessment on the Freiberg property for the cost of demolition in the amount of \$13, 860.00. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 14-05-04**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

The Trustees discussed the resignation agreement for Mr. Larry Wilson. The Trustees acknowledge they have read the agreement and fully understand the content. Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion for all Trustees to sign the resignation agreement for Mr. Larry Wilson. Mr. Sams seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 14-05-05**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).

Mr. Gene Bustle requested assistance with the 2014 Tractor Trek on June 14th. Mr. Bustle requested the use of the volunteers to escort the tractors. Mr. Bustle would like to request two volunteers again this year. The Trustees requested that the township be listed as a sponsor for the event. Mr. Sams made a motion to approve the escorts for the event. Mr. VanDeGrift seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed.

Department Reports:

Fire/EMS: Steve Flint, Fire Chief and Mike Jameson, Assistant Fire Chief reported fire and EMS incident information.

Road and Bridge: Ron Chasteen, Crew Leader, presented his weekly department activity reports completed since the previous meeting. Mr. Chasteen informed the Trustees that the first round of mowing should be completed tomorrow. Mr. Chasteen stated that he will attend the pre-construction meeting the second week of June for the annual road work. Mr. Chasteen stated that he will be reviewing the township roads to determine the status and need for repairs. Mr. Sams requested that Mr. Chasteen work on a takedown schedule for the roads to be presented to the Trustees in the future. Ms. Boggs informed the Trustees that the OPWC money for the Liberty Keuter Road project will be a 51/49 split. The township will pay \$102,000.00 for the completion of the work on this project. Mr. VanDeGrift made a motion to authorize Mr. Jones to sign the OPWC paperwork for this project and approve the \$102,000.00. Mr. Sams seconded the motion. All voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed with **Resolution 14-05-06**. (A copy of the resolution is included in the minutes).
