

TURTLECREEK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The meeting scheduled by the Board of Trustees of Turtlecreek Township for a work session to discuss the Road Department, held on November 19, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. with the following persons present:

TRUSTEES: Jonathan Sams and Spencer Cropper (Dan Jones was absent)

FISCAL OFFICER: Amanda Childers

GUEST: Tammy Boggs, Jen Patterson, Kenny Hickey, Brad Edrington and Annette Bickett.

Mr. Cropper opened the work session at 9:00 a.m. leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting agenda was to discuss Road Department review of 2026 Budget Projections.

Kenny Hickey, Road and Maintenance Supervisor, brought forth discussions regarding a 61" zero turn mower, a down cut concrete and asphalt saw, a replacement hot box, a replacement dump truck and the 2026 road resurfacing list. Mr. Hickey also provided the Board with his updated 2025 Turtlecreek Township Road Ratings report. The Trustees made many comments and asked questions which Mr. Hickey answered. The Board thanked Mr. Hickey for all of the information and data he provided. No decisions were made during the meeting.

Mrs. Boggs informed the Board that pricing had been obtained from 2 vendors for a double-sided electronic sign for Station 32. Mrs. Boggs started a discussion regarding Station 31 bids for crack seal, seal coat and striping of the parking lot as well as bids for Turtlecreek Cemetery for crack seal, Seal Coat and Line Striping for the parking lot. Mr. Hickey discussed the bid amounts and answered questions for the Board. Mrs. Boggs brought up a discussion regarding Station 32 Administration building needing exterior painting done. Mrs. Boggs and Mr. Hickey had discussed the need and obtained a quote to get an idea of the cost. Mr. Hickey noted that he is seeing some damage happening where water is getting into the block. The Board was interested in pursuing the project, so additional quotes will be obtained. Mr. Cropper and Mr. Sams asked Mrs. Boggs if she could present all of the expenses discussed and how they would affect the budget. Mrs. Boggs said she would bring the numbers back at the next meeting.

One resident was present, Annette Bickett, of Shaker Run. Mr. Sams asked Mrs. Bickett for her opinion of the new township entry signs showing drivers when they enter the Township on State Routes. Mrs. Bickett praised the signs and felt there were noticeable and at the correct height. Mrs. Bickett also informed Mr. Hickey of an issue on Greentree Road where it intersects with Shaker Run Boulevard; there is water that seems to be leaking up through the road. This is an issue with freezing temperatures in the winter. Mr. Hickey stated he had notified the County water department previously as Greentree is a county road, however he will do so again. Mr. Sams asked that the County Engineer's office also be notified. Mr. Hickey was agreeable to do so.

There being no further business Mr. Sams made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Cropper. All present voiced a "YEA" vote and the motion was passed.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for December 8, 2025 at 8:00 a.m.
